Aviation Museum(Docent): Work on the museum floor meeting the public, protecting and informing the artifacts, informing visitors about the artifacts, exhibits, and displays and providing security in the museum. A General knowledge of Aviation is a plus.

Space Museum(Docent): Work on the museum floor meeting the public, protecting and informing the artifacts, informing visitors about the artifacts, exhibits, and displays and providing security in the museum. A general knowledge of Aviation and Rocketry is a plus.

***Special Events**: Usually requires evenings or some weekends at specifically scheduled events. Some lifting is required during setup and takedown of chairs and tables, etc. This is usually done in conjunction with serving as volunteering on the Museum floor as a Docent.

***Youth Education**: Working with youth/children's groups providing direction, special activities and supervising children's area. This is usually done in conjunction with serving as volunteering on the Museum floor as a Docent.

**(In order to qualify for Volunteering in these areas, you must have worked as a docent for a period of time before being eligible for the above areas).*

***Restoration**: Restoring aircraft, artifacts, exhibits, and displays. It is a very technical area and requires a level of craftsmanship, shop and tool knowledge and also a higher level of knowledge of aviation and aircraft. This area requires an additional interview with the Department Head.

***Maintenance**: Light repair work, cleaning and dusting of aircraft, artifacts, exhibits, and displays. Requires some specialized skills. This is usually done in conjunction with serving as volunteering on the Museum floor as a Docent.

***Archives/Library**: Receiving, cataloging, and displaying donated items. Requires a higher level of detail work and ability to conduct research.
