Each year, two Yamhill County junior or Senior high school students (aged 16-18) who possess an enthusiasm for aviation are chosen to receive this scholarship. The scholarship is valued at \$2,500 and can be applied toward ground school instruction, dual and solo flight instruction, pre and post flight instruction, the FAA written test and flight examiner's fee for the private pilot check ride.

NOTE: Actual expenses to complete the training may exceed the scholarship gift amount.
