Special Events: Usually requires evenings and some weekends at specially scheduled events. Some lifting is required during set up and take down of chairs tables, etc. This is usually done in conjunction with serving as a Docent

Youth Education: Working with children’s groups providing direction, special activities and supervising children’s area. This is usually done in conjunction with serving as a Docent

Restoration: Restoring aircraft. It is a very technical area and requires a pre-interview with the director. Restoration is housed in the restoration hanger behind the Administrative Building across the highway from the museum.

Maintenance: Involves maintaining the displays on the museum floor. It requires some specialized skills.

Library / Archives: Cataloging donated items, books, pictures etc. Requires a high degree of preservation skill.
