September 22: War of the Worlds

In 1938, a radio broadcast of War of the Worlds caused a panic that Martians were invading; in 2017, we have discovered more than 3,500 planets outside of our solar system that cause nothing but excitement. Learn all about these different kinds of exoplanets – the strange, the plentiful, and even the ones that might be habitable.

October 20: Crime Lab

Put on your detective hat! Sharpen your deduction skills as you learn the tools necessary to solve a crime. Use clues such as fingerprint analysis, handwriting analysis, and paper chromatography to figure out the culprit.

November 17: Grossology

What good is mucus? Why do bacteria look so funny? Learn all about the gross things of our world right before Thanksgiving! We'll talk about viruses, diseases, and sticky stuff that you'll make for yourself.

December 8: WWII Tactics

Learn all about famous battles and conditions of World War II, including an interactive demonstration of tank battles! Directly compare these legendary vehicles, and play a strategy game that helps you gain a better understanding of tactics used in the 20th century.

January 19: Moons of the Solar System

Discover the moons of our solar system, from the formation of our own moon to the five distant moons around Pluto. Not only will you learn how to predict and track the courses of our planetary buddies, but you'll design and build your own moon settlement! Do you have what it takes to survive on a moon?

February 23: Cryptozoology

Everyone's heard of Bigfoot and the Loch Ness monster, but did you know that giant squids and gorillas used to be considered creatures of legend too? Develop critical thinking skills as you determine what is fact and what is fake – and then try your hand at making your own Bigfoot tracks.

March 23: Oceanography

Have you ever wanted to explore the ocean floors around Antarctica? Now's your chance to begin learning all about underwater exploration! Build your own submarine, and discover more about Oregon's water cycle, alternative energy, and all those creatures that live beneath the waves.

April 20: Feats of the Ancient World

Take part in several engineering challenges, recreating wonders of the ancient world. While you put together these famous marvels, discover more about their fascinating history.

May 4: Science Behind Science Fiction

May the fourth be with you! On this special Star Wars-inspired day, discover the science behind the science fiction of your favorite movies. Save the galaxy with the knowledge you gain about flying in space, spaceships, aliens, force fields, and much, much more.

June 8: Robotics

Build and program your own robot! Put your robot to the challenge as you learn about the future of robotics. Discover more about nanotechnology, bio-robotics, and artificial intelligence.
