General Rules & Information

HEALTH

For your safety, you should be in good health to participate in any water attraction. If you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason or you could aggravate a pre-existing condition, do not participate in any water attraction.

Do NOT enter any pool, water slide or water play area if you have:

- Had a stomach or intestinal illness within the past two weeks
- Have a disease communicable by water
- Open sores, cuts, or an infection

Parents should instruct their children not to drink the pool water.

Guests with casts, braces or splints are not permitted on any water slide.

Immuno-compromised persons should use caution when using a public pool.

AGE RESTRICTIONS

Wristbands must be worn at all times by all guests over 3 years of age.

Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by a supervising adult.

BEHAVIOR

There is an inherent risk in participating in any amusement ride or attraction. We expect participants to exercise good judgment and act in a responsible manner.

Guests must also obey all oral and written warnings and properly use all ride safety equipment provided.

Guests who do not comply with ride, attraction or waterpark rules will be ejected from the waterpark without a refund.

Running, horseplay and diving are not permitted in any area of the waterpark. Line jumping and place holding are not permitted.

Profanity and abusive language, symbols or gestures are not permitted.

Smoking is not permitted in the waterpark or within 10 feet of any entrance or exit.

No glass, plastic that can shatter, cigarettes or food should be brought into the water slide area.

CLOTHING

Swimwear and clothing must be family-friendly. Swimwear or clothing with rude, vulgar or offensive language or graphics is not permitted.

Provocative swimwear and long pants are not permitted. Denim, cut-offs or swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation are not permitted.

T-shirts and rash guards/surf shirts are not permitted on any body slide.

U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets should be worn by guests under 48" tall and weak or non-swimmers. Courtesy lifejackets are provided free of charge and located throughout the waterpark on a first serve basis. Courtesy lifejackets are not permitted outside of the waterpark.

All diaper-dependant guests must wear a protective swim diaper. Diaper changing stations are located inside of the restrooms. Diaper changing is not permitted anywhere outside of the restrooms.

WHAT CAN & CANNOT COME INTO THE PARK

Pets are not permitted in the waterpark. Working service animals are permitted in the waterpark, but not in any pool, water slide or water play area.

Outside food and beverages are not permitted. Guests with special medical or dietary needs will be accommodated on a case by case basis. Glass and other breakable containers are not permitted.

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted. Any guest that is under the influence of alcohol or drugs is not permitted on the campus.

Only U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are permitted for use in the waterpark.

Outside inflatable items and water toys are not permitted in the waterpark.

LOCKERS / PHOTOGRAPHY / MAINTENANCE

Evergreen Wings & Waves Waterpark and its staff are not responsible for items that are lost, stolen or damaged. Never leave your property unattended. Loose articles are not permitted on any water slide and should be left with a non-riding member of your party. Lockers are provided for a nominal fee on a first serve basis.

Camera phones or any type of photography are not permitted in any changing areas or restrooms, or on any slide. By entering the waterpark, each guest grants Evergreen Wings & Waves Waterpark the right to film, videotape or photograph him/her on waterpark property for any reason without payment or consideration. Guests must have written permission to use photographs and/or videotape of Evergreen Wings & Waves Waterpark for commercial broadcasting, advertising, marketing or publishing in any medium.

At times, one or more of our attractions may be temporarily out of service due to scheduled maintenance or unplanned events. Evergreen Wings & Waves Waterpark does not issue refunds.

Hygiene

NOTICE

Pool hygiene is important so sicknesses and disease are not spread to you or others.

Help keep the water clean and healthy for everyone by obeying these rules:

All guests must take a cleansing shower prior to using any pool, water slide or water play area.

All guests must take a cleansing shower after using the toilet, before using any pool, water slide or water play area.



Do not urinate or defecate in the pool.

Do not drink or spit pool water.

All persons who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.

Prolonged exposure to chlorinated water may cause a skin reaction to guests with sensitive skin. We suggest taking a shower after using the pool. (For further information on the proper treatment for this condition, ask one of our life guard supervisors).

Safety

For your safety:

- Obey the rules provided by the staff and signs at all times
- Read and follow the specific guidelines posted at the entrance of each pool, water slide and water play area.

DANGER

NO diving!

Shallow water. Prevent spine injuries.
ONLY enter feet first.



NO prolonged breath holding or underwater swimming.

Competitive and repetitive breath holding can be deadly! Doing so tells your body not to ask for oxygen, which can cause you to pass out and drown.



Closely watch your children.

It only takes seconds for a child to drown. Your child's safety is your responsibility.



Drowning hazard.

Non-swimmers and children under 48" should wear lifejacket!



WARNING

Pregnant women and persons with heart conditions or back trouble should NOT ride slides.



Eye glasses must be securely affixed to riders with head straps.

Note: Water depths are posted at each pool.

747 Ride Rules



SIZE AND WEIGHT LIMITS

These are 1 or 2 person rides



Maximum weight is 400 lbs. (180 kg) per tube



Minimum height is 42" (1.22m)



CORRECT RIDE POSITION

ONLY ride tubes in a seated position, facing forward.



Or



Keep arms and hands inside the slide at all times.

RIDE INSTRUCTIONS

Only ONE tube to enter slide flume at a time. NEVER form chains.

Riders must WAIT for attendant's start signal before starting slide.

Riders must stay on the tubes during the ride. If you accidentally fall from the tube, continue down the slide without it and exit normally.

DO NOT run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate or stop in the slide.



EXIT INSTRUCTIONS

At the end of the slide, obey all instructions by splash pool attendant and EXIT QUICKLY, taking your tube with you.

No swimming in the shutdown lane or splash pool. No flotation devices in the shutdown lane.



747 Ride Rules (cont.)



SIZE AND WEIGHT LIMITS

This is a 1 person ride



Maximum weight is 300 lbs. (136 kg)



Minimum height is 48" (1.22m)



CORRECT RIDE POSITION

ONLY ride slide feet first lying on your back with your legs firmly crossed at the ankles and arms folded across your chest (to prevent your elbows from contacting the flume).



DO NOT uncross your legs or attempt to sit up until you come to a stop in the pool.

RIDE INSTRUCTIONS

Only ONE rider to enter slide flume at a time. Single riders ONLY. NEVER form chains.

Riders must WAIT for attendant's start signal before starting slide.

DO NOT run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate or stop in the slide.

EXIT INSTRUCTIONS

At the end of the slide, obey all instructions by splash pool attendant and EXIT QUICKLY.

No swimming in the shutdown lane or splash pool. No flotation devices in the shutdown lane.



Aquaplay Area Rules

GENERAL RULES

An adult **MUST** supervise children under 6.

NO running on or around the water play structure.

NO headfirst sliding on slides or in tunnels.

NO climbing on pipes or handrails.

NO hanging or swinging on pull ropes.

Children and adults **ARE** encouraged to play with the valves and handles of this play unit. Turn, pull and open these valves to have fun with the water effect they will create.



SIZE AND WEIGHT LIMITS FOR SLIDES

These are 1 person slides

Maximum weight is 300 lbs. (136 kg)



Minimum height is 40" (1.02m) for the 10' (3m) slide and 36" (.91m) for the 8' (2.5m) slides.

CORRECT RIDE POSITIONS

ONLY ride slides feet first lying on your back or sitting facing forward.

RIDE INSTRUCTIONS

Riders must **WAIT** for the ride to be clear or attendant's start signal before starting slide.

Keep your hands inside the flumes at all times.

DO NOT run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate or stop in the slide.

EXIT INSTRUCTIONS

At the end of the slide, obey all instructions by splash pool attendant and **EXIT QUICKLY**.



Spa Rules

All persons must take a cleansing shower before entering the spa.

Elderly persons and those suffering from heart disease, diabetes or high blood pressure should consult their physician before using the spa.



No persons suffering from a communicable disease, transmissible via water, shall use the spa. Persons using prescription medications should consult their physician before using the spa.

No person shall use the spa alone.

Persons should spend no more than 15 minutes in the spa at any one session.

All children under 14 years of age shall be accompanied by a responsible adult observer.

No person shall run or engage in horseplay in or around the spa.

Individuals under the influence of alcohol should not use the spa.

Pregnant women should not use the spa without consulting their physician.
